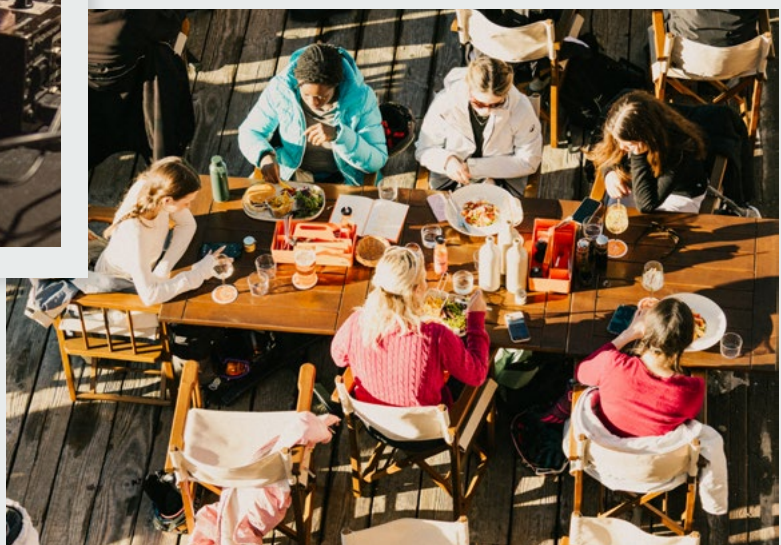
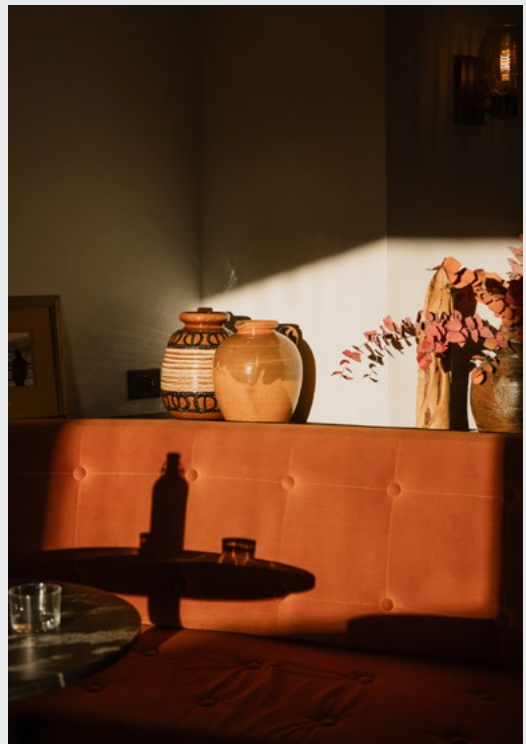

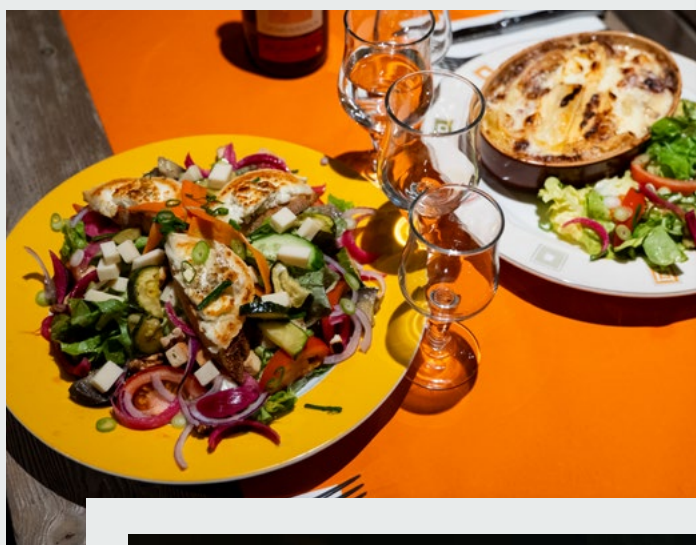
1971, BAR-RESTAURANT AND TERRACE

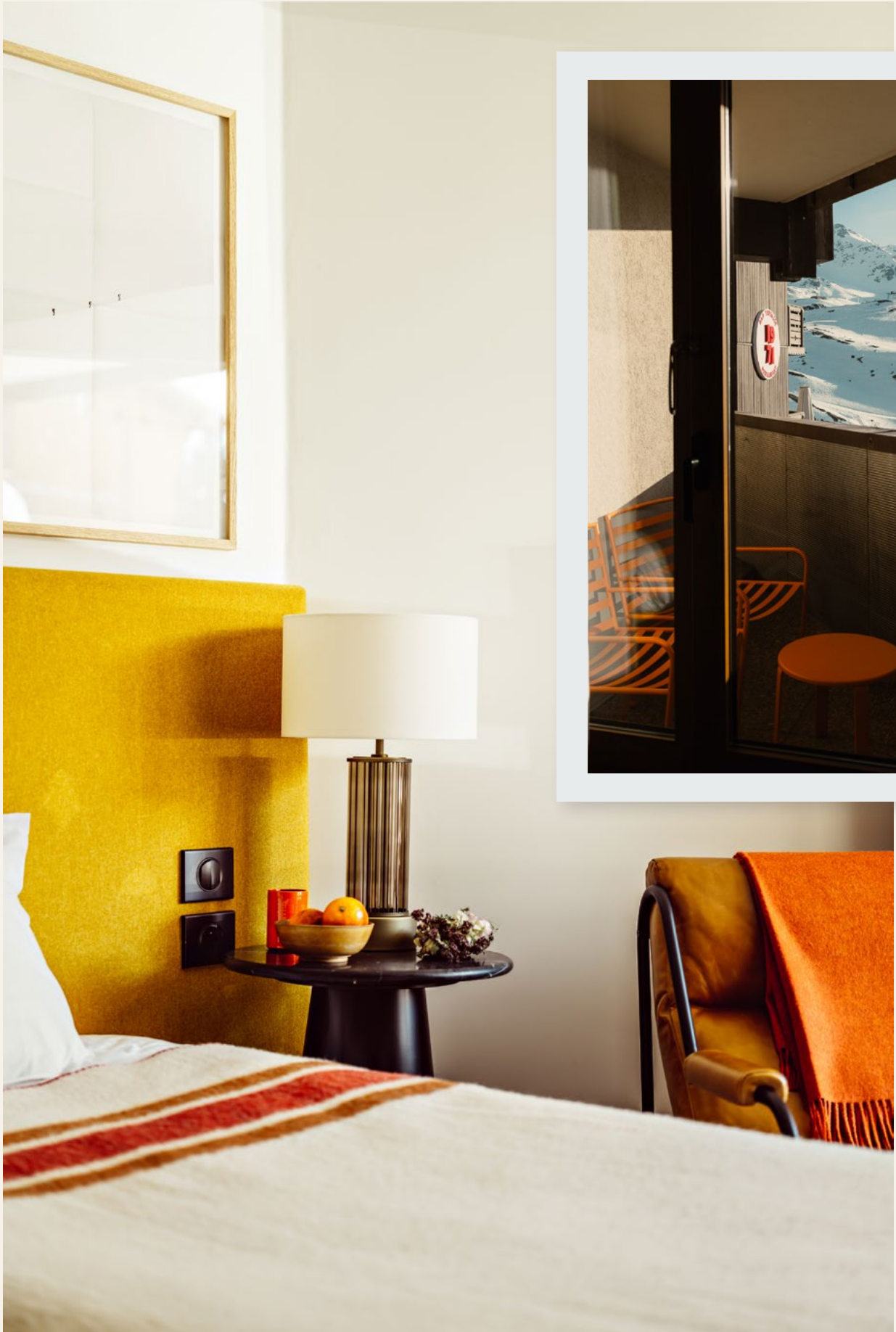

A location as rich as this means there are endless ways to spend the day. For the moments when you want to stay closer to home instead of venturing afield, our Alpine retreat will bring you joy.

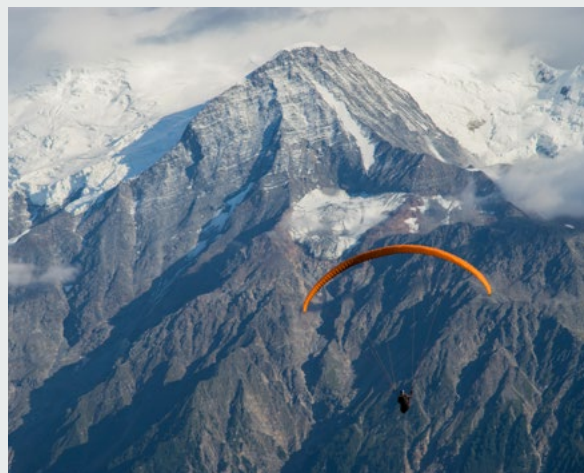
WELLNESS

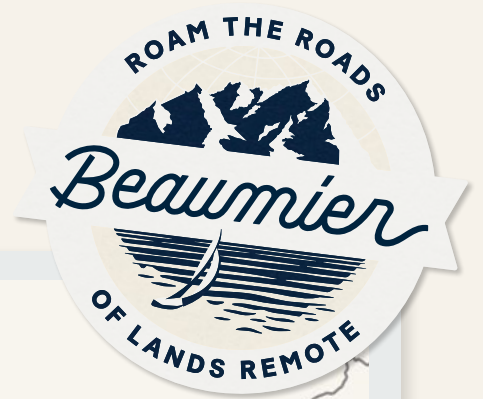

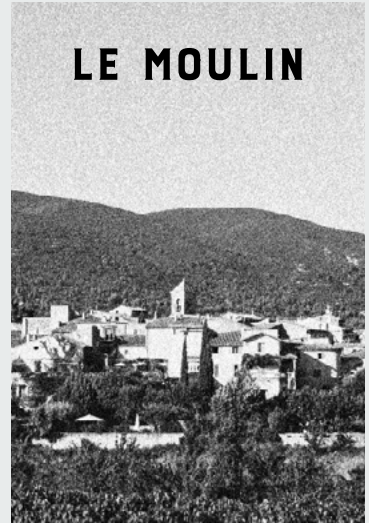
